#### **WORLD POPULATION DAY**



## **PHYSICS QUIZ COMPETITION**


Physics Quiz competition for SYJC Science was conducted on 19th July 2025 at 1:00 p.m. in the IT Lab.


#### FYIC ORIENTATION PROGRAM- 2025-2026
